Landscape Officer Update—April 2024

Malleefowl Workshops

Over the last fortnight, Libby Hunt (from Streaky Bay) and myself brought Malleefowl workshops to 80 primary age students at Karcultaby Area School and Miltaburra Area School.

The workshops covered Malleefowl habitat, morphology, monitoring techniques and feral predator control. Students learnt about Malleefowl threats and habitat disturbance along with how integrating conservation with agriculture can increase the species' chance of survival.

The students were highly engaged in a role play activity learning about threats and habitat disturbance along with how integrating conservation with agriculture can increase the species' chance of survival.

The workshops culminated with students creating a Malleefowl habitat collage. Looking forward to bring more workshops to schools in the future!

Malleefowl are listed as vulnerable in Australia and on Eyre

Peninsula their numbers are declining. We are involved with an annual monitoring program and also encourage the community to submit sightings to us at www.landscape.sa.gov.au/ep/malleefowl

Opuntia Cacti and the Cochineal Biocontrol's

Opuntia cacti plants should be controlled as they can spread very easily. The ripe fruit is an attractive meal to birds and foxes, which, after consuming the animal then deposits the seeds through their faeces. New plants can easily grow from pads that have been knocked off existing plants; so this species can spread very quickly into surrounding areas including pastoral regions, rangelands and native vegetation.

Cactus moth (Cactoblastis cactorum) and some species of the cochineal mealy bug (Dactylopius sp) have been introduced on the Eyre Peninsula. This utilises natural control agents to decrease the density and abundance of the cacti population. It is suited to large or remote locations and can be easily spread. Biocontrol's are only active in the warm months and are dormant over winter. Cochineal biocontrol's are specific to Opuntia species and ineffective unless the correct biotype is used.

All Opuntia cacti excluding spineless Opuntia ficus-indica and Tephrocactus spp. (prickly pear) are declared under the Landscape South Australia Act 2019. This means it is illegal to transport or sell these plants and all property owners have a responsibility to control Opuntia cacti on their property. Residents who rent their properties also have obligations to control declared species. This also includes anyone who is leasing property unless other arrangements have been made.

With the help of the Eastern Team, I have started some cochineal nurseys around the district. I would greatly appreciate if anyone knows, or sees any cactus while out and about, to please report them to me - along with GPS coordinates.

Controlling Feral Deer and Goats on Eyre Peninsula

Grazing pressure from feral herbivore species such as deer and goats is having a detrimental effect on natural habitats across Eyre Peninsula (EP). Aside from overgrazing and soil erosion, they are also a vector for disease and cause significant damage to agriculture. Declared for control under the Landscape South Australia Act 2019 both species are increasing in abundance across EP.

This year's Landscape Priority Funding as seen \$275,000 dedicated for this project to reduce the impacts of pest herbivores across land tenures through:

- Targeted control of deer populations using thermal assisted aerial control (TAAC)
- Widespread control of goats using TAAC and traditional aerial control methods.
- Follow-up compliance with landholders to ensure any ongoing pest herbivore control is maintained.

To assist with this program, I encourage everyone to please report any feral deer or goat sightings in the district (with GPS coordinates) to myself.
