
As of 1 March 2024, new legislation bans the smoking and vaping in a variety of public outdoor areas in South Australia. These new laws, introduced by the South Australian Government, protect the community from passive exposure to tobacco smoke and e-cigarette aerosol. The comfort and enjoyment for users is paramount, and the new legislation addresses the risks associated with passive tobacco smoking and passive inhalation of e-cigarette aerosol. The 10 metre boundary rule applies to outdoor areas in all public areas:

| Within childhood services, education and children's services facilities (including schools) | At outdoor swimming facilities |
|--|--|
| At and within 10 metres of non-residential building entrances; such as entrances to shopping centres, government and commercial buildings | Within major event venues under the Major Events Act 2013 |
| Within public hospitals, public health facilities, private hospitals and residential aged care facilities and within 10 metres of their boundaries | At and within 10 metres of a sporting venue during an organised underage sporting event, training or practice session |
| On beaches between and within 50 metres of red and yellow patrol flags and within 5 metres of jetties | |

The maximum penalty of \$750 and explation fee of \$105 applies to a person smoking or using e-cigarettes in a public area declared by the regulations. The occupier (eg owner/proprietor) and/or the organisation responsible for administration of the outdoor public area needs to ensure signs in sufficient numbers are placed in the smoke-free and vape-free area, and in positions likely to be seen by persons within the area. A maximum penalty of \$750 applies if this law is not enforced.

Landscape Officer Update—March 2024

Annual Shorebird Surveys

This year's surveys was kicked off with workshops at Ceduna and Streaky bay. We appreciate everyone that made the time to come out with us and BirdLife and looking forward to the next.

The Western Eyre Peninsula supports up to 21 of the 38 international migratory shorebird species, which travel thousands of kilometres to reach Australian shores every summer.

Thirty western EP count areas from Lake Newland to Cactus Beach were surveyed during February, with hopefully good bird numbers recorded at each site. From rocky platforms to offshore islands, marshy samphires and sandy beaches, these count areas are critical habitat for the feeding, roosting and resting of our resident and migratory shorebirds.

It will be interesting to get an insight of the diversity of shorebirds around our region, many of which are returning to the same shorebird area every year, allowing comparisons to be drawn. Data collected during the surveys is fed into the Birdlife database which contains the most comprehensive shorebird data available in Australia. This data is used to uncover significant population changes over the long term and identify and protect critical areas for shorebirds.

If you are interested in becoming a volunteer bird watcher please get in contact with myself.




At this stage, it is anticipated that eligible residents and businesses will be able to order a service from their preferred Retail service provider mid-May.

Council has reviewed it's suite of By Laws to provide local level governance. These By Laws became effective 24 December 2023.


As part of the review, new By Laws have been enacted in the management and control of Dogs and Cats in the Council area:

1. By Law 5 Dogs 2023 By Law 6 Cats 2023

The Animal Management Plan 2019 – 2024 called for By Law consideration where many of the regulatory issues that have required Council or RSPCA intervention with Dog and Cat Management arise where there is an excess of animals on a premises or site.

Complaints under the Dog and Cat Management Act 1995 will continue to be managed by Council and under the Animal Welfare Act 1985 by the RSPCA. These By—Laws will assist in reducing the potential for issues to arise under these State Acts and have been vetted and approved by the Dog and Cat Management Board and the State Legislative Review Committee.


