## Game On! Eyre Peninsula Regional Games is coming to Wudinna

Save the Date: Adelaide Cup Long Weekend, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021

Wudinna & Districts Business & Tourism Association has been exploring running an Eyre Peninsula Regional Games, and after strong interest and support from a number of sporting groups in the district, submitted an application titled 'Game On!' for some event funding from the State Government to support the idea.

Last week the Association was advised they were successful for a grant of \$9,750 to assist with covering costs like insurance and coordination resources to pull it together.

"This is a great outcome for the district", President of Wudinna & Districts Business & Tourism Association said when announcing the funding. "After all the drought and COVID-19, this gives us something to aim for in the new year".

The purpose of the event is to bring together people from across the region over the Adelaide Cup Long Weekend in March 2021, and help stimulate the local economy and provide an opportunity for local clubs to raise some much needed funds. It is also aimed to attract the interest of people in Adelaide or who are already travelling who might like to head to Wudinna over the long weekend and participate the event.

Game On! Will be a great chance to showcase some of the great sport and recreation opportunities across the district that include swimming, football and netball, cricket, golf, cross country running, walking, table tennis, lawn bowls, tennis, darts, a pump track event and even squash. In the true spirit of a games event, an opening and closing ceremony is planned and perhaps even a torch relay.

Planning will now begin in earnest with sporting groups invited to become involved. The first meeting has been scheduled for Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September, to be held at Wudinna Community Club, commencing at 7:30pm.

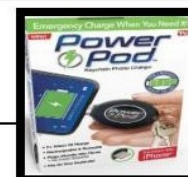

## The Word for Today

### Forgive and Move On

**'Forgetting what is behind and straining towards what is ahead, I press on.' Philippians 3:13-14 NIV**

The greater the offence, the harder it is to forgive—but you must. Because whatever you refuse to forgive and let go of, you carry with you. And it will be like a concrete block strapped around your neck.

Has someone mistreated you, cheated you, lied about you or fired you? Have you failed yourself? Are you asking, 'How can I get beyond my past mistakes and become successful again?' Whatever your particular hurt, the solution isn't feeding it or denying it. You have to forgive and let it go, or you will continue to hurt yourself.

It's often said that choosing not to forgive somebody is like drinking poison and expecting the other person to die. In order to move forward, you have to 'let go' and be at peace with the past. Paul could easily have allowed the memory of the Christians he put to death before meeting Christ to destroy him and rob him of his destiny. But he refused to do it.

Instead he wrote: *'Dear brothers [and sisters], I am still not all that I should be, but I am bringing all my energies to bear on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead, I strain to reach the end of the race and receive the prize for which God is calling us up to Heaven because of what Christ Jesus did for us.'* (Philippians 3:13–14 TLB) And here's one more Scripture: *'If you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in Heaven may forgive you your sins.'* (Mark 11:25 NIV)

So, the word for today is— 'Forgive and move on.'

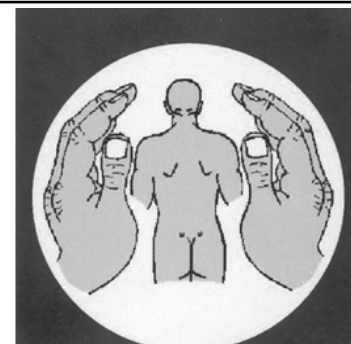

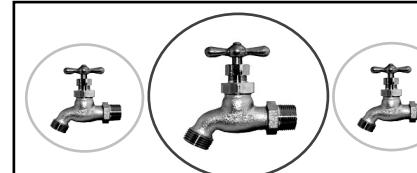

## The Yaninee Institute

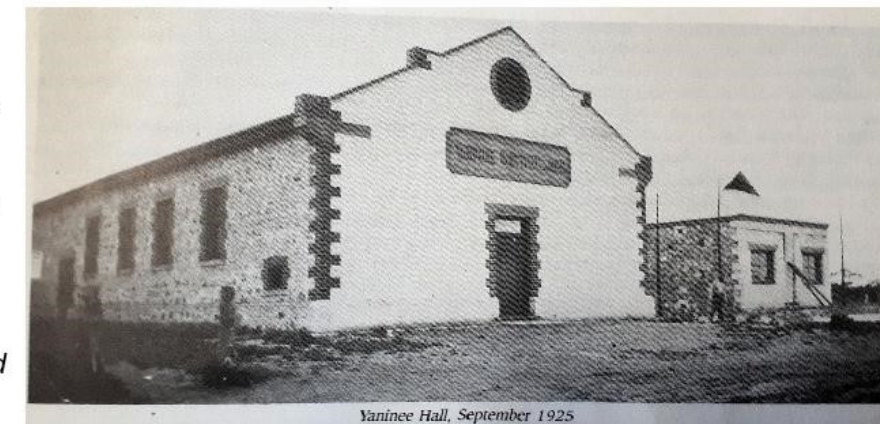
The Yaninee Institute is approaching 100 years old and will celebrate in 2025.

Did you know that it is the oldest and only building of it's type still standing in the Council District. It has historical and architectural value.

"Yaninee Institute. Local limestone structure opened in 1925. Roads were poor in the early days and so small settlements like Yaninee needed to be as self-reliant as possible. A general store opened in 1917 followed soon after by a Post Office, a blacksmith, and a saddlers shop.

When the town was declared, a government reserve was set aside for a public hall. The local men got together in 1918 and ordered timber which was railed to the site and they worked overnight to erect a small wooden public hall suitable for use as a church, school and social centre. Thus the Yaninee School opened in 1918 in the hall. The timber Yaninee Hall was replaced with a fine stone hall in 1925 which is still used by the local community."

Eligible sporting clubs and organisations can now apply for **up to \$3,000** for funding of programs and equipment through Round 49 of the Active Club Program (ACP): the 'Club Reboot Round'.

\$2,495,000 is available in the 2020-21 ACP to help the sport sector rebuild following the COVID-19 pandemic. As organisations adapt to the 'new normal', funds may be used to purchase digital equipment to enable holding meetings remotely, hand sanitiser, cleaning products etc. Equipment, uniforms and training aids can also be purchased with the funding.

#### Who can apply?

To be eligible for the ACP, applicants must be ALL of the following:

- A not-for-profit active recreation or sport club or community organisation whose purpose is the delivery of active recreation or sport programs and services in South Australia.
- Incorporated under the *Associations Incorporations Act 1985 (SA)* or have some other comparable legal status.
- Have a minimum total membership base of 20 members. Total membership can include associate, social and life membership.
- Be operating for 12 months or longer.

The ACP aligns with the objectives of the [Game On](#) initiative, which aims to get South Australians more active more often and enjoying the many social, health and lifestyle benefits sport and recreation provide.

All program funds must be expended by successful applicants within 12 months of receiving funding.

50% reimbursement of water and sewerage bills for eligible clubs for Quarter 4, 2019-20

### EXTENDED: Water Relief Grants for Sporting Clubs

The Water Relief Grants for eligible sporting clubs has been extended until September. To support those clubs that have significant water bills to pay, the State Government will provide financial assistance towards water and sewerage bills issued between April and June 2020.

The grant is being funded from the Community and Jobs Support Fund as part of the State Government's broader \$650 million Jobs Rescue Package.

**Eligible sporting clubs/associations will receive a grant equivalent to 50% of the water and sewerage bill issued between 1 April and 30 June 2020.**

#### Who can apply?

To be eligible for this grant, a sporting club must:

- Be an incorporated sporting club in South Australia that maintains facilities and grounds\* that require significant water usage.
- Have annual grouped Australian payroll of less than \$1.5 million, and not be entitled to a payroll tax waiver under the State Government's COVID-19 support measures.
- Be responsible for paying a SA Water (or other water supplier) water and sewerage bill directly or explicitly required to pay for water as part of its lease arrangements e.g. the club makes a specific water contribution as part of its lease to the lessor.

**Applications for this grant will be open until Wednesday 30 September 2020.**

\*Facilities and grounds exclude hard courts, indoor facilities etc. (e.g. netball courts, basketball courts, volleyball courts or hardcourt tennis courts).

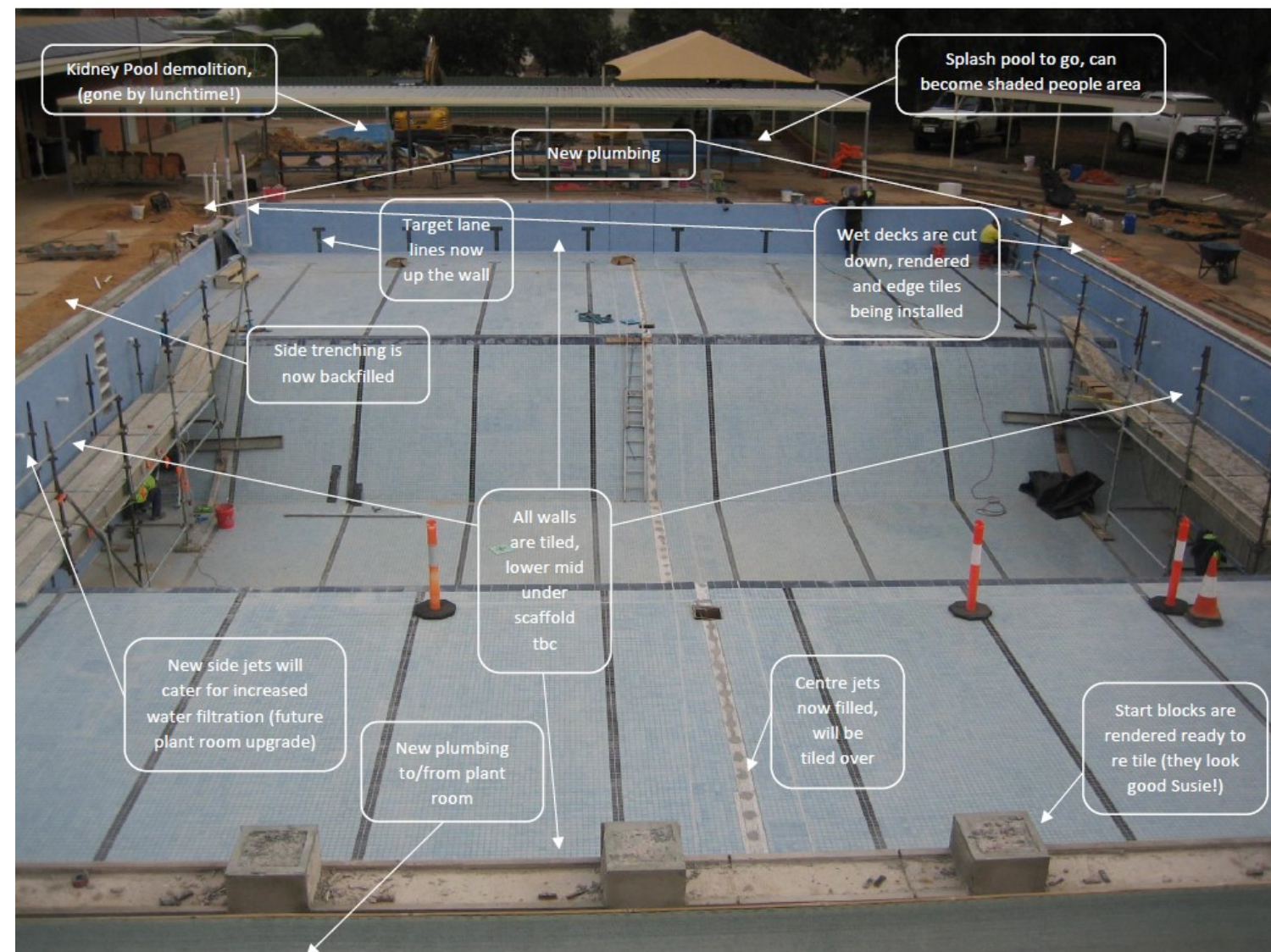

### Police incidents of note

Well, I'm pleased to report that there have been no real incidents in Wudinna worth reporting for this month's granite. I was recalled to an incident out at Venus Bay on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> August where a male was later arrested for firearms offences after I located a TASER, sawn-off shotgun and ammunition under the driver's seat of his car. The male and his partner had travelled to the area from Victoria (pre COVID). He was remanded in custody and will have conditions to leave Venus Bay on his release.

### A few points

Unfortunately there was a rise in speeding vehicles in the town. Several vehicles were stopped heading east out of town after travelling through the signed 60 speed limit. All of the vehicles except one had just collected their children from school and were heading home.

I don't stop vehicles for travelling 'just over' the speed limit. I can tell you that the fastest was 86kmh adjacent to Mogas. A fine at this speed would cost you \$870 and 5 demerit points.

If this still doesn't encourage you to ease off on the flux capacitor then feel free to volunteer for your local ambos or CFS in order to witness first-hand the devastation that a speed related collision can cause.

I have issued a disproportionate amount of cautions to drivers which is actually frowned upon within SAPOL as speeding is one of the fatal 5 offences where I am supposed to take a zero tolerance approach. I can only urge you not to take advantage of my good nature in this area. It would be a shame if I have to hand out monetary fines to reinforce the issue!!

**COVID** - Please be mindful of current COVID restrictions. Marshalling of various premises is now in force and I don't want to hear that punters have been giving those responsible a hard time. Unfortunately it's one big manure sandwich and we've all got to take a bite!!

I'll be doing some walk-throughs of the pub. I'm not there to dish out fines to anyone and I'm sure some friendly advice would be well received.

**FIREARMS** – Please make yourselves familiar with the current storage regulations for firearms. Every year I get allocated a random list of firearms holders to check. I am still coming across breaches from non-compliant safes, incorrectly stored ammunition, missing firearms or even firearms that shouldn't be there at all!

You can check the SAPOL website (Firearms Information Guides - Storage of Firearms).

The new legislation has been in place now since 1<sup>st</sup> July 2017 so there's been plenty of time to get your storage upgraded. If you've applied for a licence recently I can only apologise if you've not had the authorisation back in time for the practical course. This happens a lot when a course comes up. Everyone puts in their application at the last minute and as a result, there's a backlog.

If you see me out running and I ignore you, it's because I've got my music on. If I shout at you, again, it's because I've got my music on. If you try and flag me down then you're only going to see a clean pair of heels.

### FENCE AND BOUNDARY AWARENESS

A fence being built between neighbouring properties should be located on a property boundary. Fences not located exactly on a boundary does not change the position of the boundary or the legal rights to ownership of the land, even if neighbours agreed to fence position.

Although a fence is considered equally shared there is no legal obligation for your neighbour to contribute towards the cost of repairing, maintaining or erecting a fence unless:

- they have agreed to it
- the proper notices have been given
- a court orders them to.
