## Wudinna Anzac Day Service

Despite the chilly weather, around 120 people attended the Wudinna Anzac Day dawn service on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April at Standley Park, to commemorate all Australians who have served and died in military operations.

April 25<sup>th</sup> marks the day that Australian and New Zealand forces landed at Gallipoli in 1915, where they were met with intense resistance from the Ottoman Turkish defenders. The allied forces were evacuated from the peninsula after a gruelling eight-month-long campaign, which resulted in heavy losses on both sides. More than 8000 Australian soldiers died during the Gallipoli campaign.

Wudinna Mayor Eleanor Scholz delivered the 2024 Anzac Day address, which was followed by the Prayer of Remembrance, delivered by Deputy Mayor Naomi Scholz. Wudinna resident and returned serviceman, Wes Jericho, laid a wreath and delivered the Ode of Remembrance. Wudinna resident Roddy Scholz then

delivered the Closing Prayer. The service was followed by a community breakfast at the Wudinna Community Club, which was attended by 70 people.

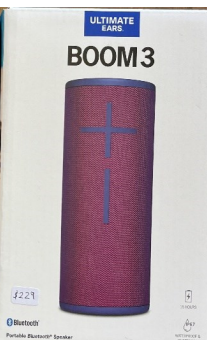

## The Word for Today

### Take it easy, Mum

*‘Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought ...’ Romans 12:3 NIV*

An old, tired-looking dog wandered into a woman’s garden. She could tell from looking at him that he had a good home. He followed her inside, down the hall, and promptly fell asleep. Two hours later, he went to the door, and she let him out. The next day, he came back, resumed his position, and napped for a couple of hours. This went on for a week.

Curious, the woman pinned this note to his collar: ‘Every afternoon, your dog comes to my house for a nap.’ The next day, the dog showed up with a note that read: ‘He lives at home with ten children. Apparently, he needs some quiet time. Can I come with him tomorrow?’

If you’re a mother, you can probably relate! Carla Barnhill, author of *The Myth of the Perfect Mother*, writes: ‘I just can’t do it anymore. I can’t keep trying to be Super Mum. I wasn’t all that good at it, to begin with. I’ve tried to be the perfect combination of devoted mum ... loving wife ... solid Christian ... and have failed miserably ... But even if I had been able to pull all of that off, I’m not convinced any of us should ... we don’t have to be impressive ... or follow some random rules about what motherhood should look like. Grace means we already matter to the One who matters most, our good, loving, and grace-filled God!

So, let’s drop our capes, put down our halos, retire our medals, and let ourselves be the sometimes flawed, sometimes awesome mums God made us to be.’ In other words: ‘Try to have a sane estimate of your capabilities.’

## SA's regional communities to thrive with funding to new projects

The Malinauskas State Government has allocated an additional \$800,000 in funding to support community projects in regional South Australia following the immense popularity of its Thriving Communities Program.

Delivered through the Thriving Regions Fund, the program provides small grants to associations and charities for projects that build social resilience through facilitating greater community participation, a sense of belonging and ease of access.

The grants range from \$20,000 to \$50,000 and are used to fund initiatives such as new or improved infrastructure and equipment, access to services and programs or events with wellbeing outcomes.

An additional 21 projects have had their applications granted as a result of the funding.

An extension to the Jamestown shearing training centre, new machinery and tools at the Millicent Men's Shed metal workshop and a new playground and shaded area at the Lochiel Community Centre are among the successful projects.

There are also upgrades to community kitchens in Tulka, Frances and Kalangadoo and restoration works at the Mt McKenzie Hall and at Minlaton's Heritage Show Pavilion.

There will also be an upgrade to the Ngarrindjeri Ruwe Empowered Communities group's Murray Bridge facilities. Last year, the Department of Primary Industries and Regions (PIRSA) funded 17 projects through the Thriving Communities Program.

The Kyancutta Community Club has been allocated \$45,000 for the establishment of a safe and family friendly outdoor area including a semi-enclosed shelter and a playground.

### Weed alert: Khaki Weed - *Alternanthera pungens*



A creeping herb with stems up to 60cm long. The vegetative growth on the surface is annual and dies off over the cooler months leaving a large perennial taproot beneath the surface.

Khaki weed reproduces both vegetatively from roots and by stems. Seeds will usually germinate in the spring but can also germinate in response to summer rain. New growth is produced from the root crown in the following spring.

The deep tap root makes Khaki weed relatively drought tolerant. It is a prolific seeder, with seeds remaining viable for up to 4-5 years in some areas. The burr containing the seeds readily becomes attached to just about any surface, meaning animals, clothing and car tyres act as perfect vessels for spread. The burrs will also respond to water movement and disperse into new territory using water as transportation. The pest will often be found along roadsides, camping grounds, town streets and waste areas particularly favouring areas that receive water over the warmer months.

Manual and chemical control are the most effective way at controlling Khaki Weed as it is declared under the *Landscape South Australia Act 2019*. This means it is illegal to transport or sell this plant and all property owners have a responsibility to control Khaki Weed on their property. Residents who rent their properties also have obligations to control any weeds present.

# Child Development Checks

## What are they?

Child development checks assess important areas of a child's development, such as communication, motor skills, problem solving and social/emotional development.

These checks are conducted by a trained professional (Registered Nurse).

## Why are they important?

A child development check can identify your child's strengths as well as areas where your child may need additional support during their early years.

It is recommended that children have at least three development checks from birth to 5 years around the milestones ages of: 6 months, 12 months, 18-24 months, 3 years and 4-5 years.

If you consent for your child to receive a check:

- a trained health professional will conduct a free development check with you and your child.
- you will receive personal and confidential feedback summarising the outcome of your child's check.

If the check identifies your child would benefit from further support, the team can assist with referrals to allied health professionals, paediatrician/s or other community agencies.

## PILDAPPA ROCK RECREATION RESERVE UPDATE

Stage One of the Pildappa Rock Recreation Reserve Masterplan redevelopment is now complete.

This stage of the redevelopment saw the upgrade and resurfacing of the main entry road and the full looping road that surrounds Pildappa Rock. Temporary directional signage has been installed to assist with traffic management.

A new walking trail has also been created, providing visitors with a walkway around Pildappa Rock. The path crosses over the loop road at various points – please ensure you take care when crossing.

Stage Two of the Pildappa Rock Recreation Reserve Master Plan will include the following elements:

- New shaded shelters
- New tables & seating
- New BBQs
- New fully accessible toilet block
- New entry and directional signage
- Additional parking options

Overnight camping is no longer available within the Pildappa Rock Recreation Reserve. A private Bush Camping option is currently under development at an adjoining property.

Pildappa Rock Recreation Reserve is a work-in-progress, and every effort is being made to ensure that works are completed in a timely manner.

## STRIKE FORCE LASER TAG A BIG HIT IN WUDINNA

The team from Strike Force Laser Tag rolled onto the Eyre Peninsula for three-days of youth-focused activity in Streaky Bay, Wudinna & Kimba.

On Tuesday, April 16, they brought their high-tech equipment and simple form infrastructure to Wudinna for 4-hours of laser tag fun, following on from the first day of **Step It Up** School Holiday Dance sessions. Energy levels were high (as was the volume of noise from the participants) as friends and family members played together or on opposing teams.

Players from different age ranges – from 6 to 16 – battled it out for Laser Tag supremacy – in free-for-all and teams-based (classic Red vs. Blue) rounds – on the Wudinna Outdoor Basketball Court, with the last hour taking place under lights.

Each player was equipped with a vibrating headband – to let them know when they’d been ‘tagged’ – and a futuristic laser rifle. A pre-session technical and safety briefing was provided to ensure participants understood how the laser rifles worked (and which buttons **not** to touch) and to keep everyone safe on the court.

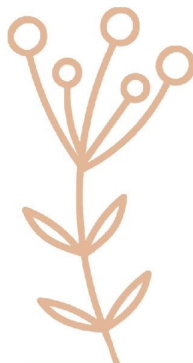
The Yaninee Anzac Sports attracted a large crowd, visitors being present from as far afield as Poochera and Cowell.

Although twenty-five points of rain fell over the week-end the weather cleared up and the sports were conducted in sunny weather.

Winners of events were:—

Sheffield, L. Hill; 4 mile bike race, M. Kutz (Poochera) first, L. Scholz second; boys' bike race (under 12), A. Bilske; stepping the distance (women), Mrs N. George; (men), H. B. Scholz; sheaf tossing, L. Roe; married women's race, Mrs. J. Wilkins; hurdle race, G. Cleve; and the trotting event was won by Russell Hancock.

Luncheon was served on the ground.



### White Wreath on Anzac Day

The first day to be called Anzac Day was 13 October 1915. This event was more of a patriotic carnival designed to raise awareness of, and funds for, the war effort than the solemn commemoration it was to become. Anzac Day as we know it was first observed on 25 April 1916, as people came together to honour those lost at Gallipoli. This Anzac Day a white wreath will be laid at the Minnipa War Memorial to not only commemorate those soldiers lost overseas during war but also those veterans who return home only to lose their lives to suicide.

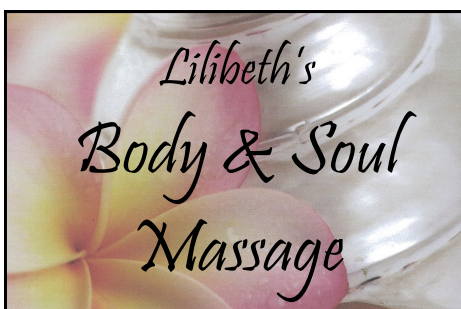

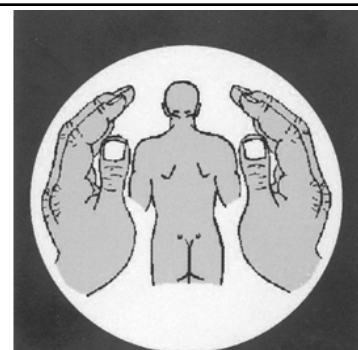
